Live, study, and travel in Britain for five weeks. Study British society in the last three centuries by examining their lived life, artifacts, and key works of fiction, autobiography, and history. No previous British history assumed. Both History majors and nonmajors will benefit by studying social class in its pre-modern and modern, rural and urban settings. We will be based both in the country (Harlaxton Manor, now a college with library, classrooms, computer access, free bicycles, etc.) and in London (Queen Mary College). Among our many planned trips are Chatsworth Hall (used as "Pemberley Hall" in the new *Pride and Prejudice*), Cambridge University (where you will punt along the River Cam), Bath (the 18th-century Las Vegas), and an insider's guide to the

Houses of Parliament (see website <http://ux1.eiu.edu/~nekey/syllabi/harlaxton/> for further details). Housing, travel, and meals included in the cost, and most weekends are reserved for student independent travel (students should budget for meals, entertainment, or shopping during optional individual travel).
