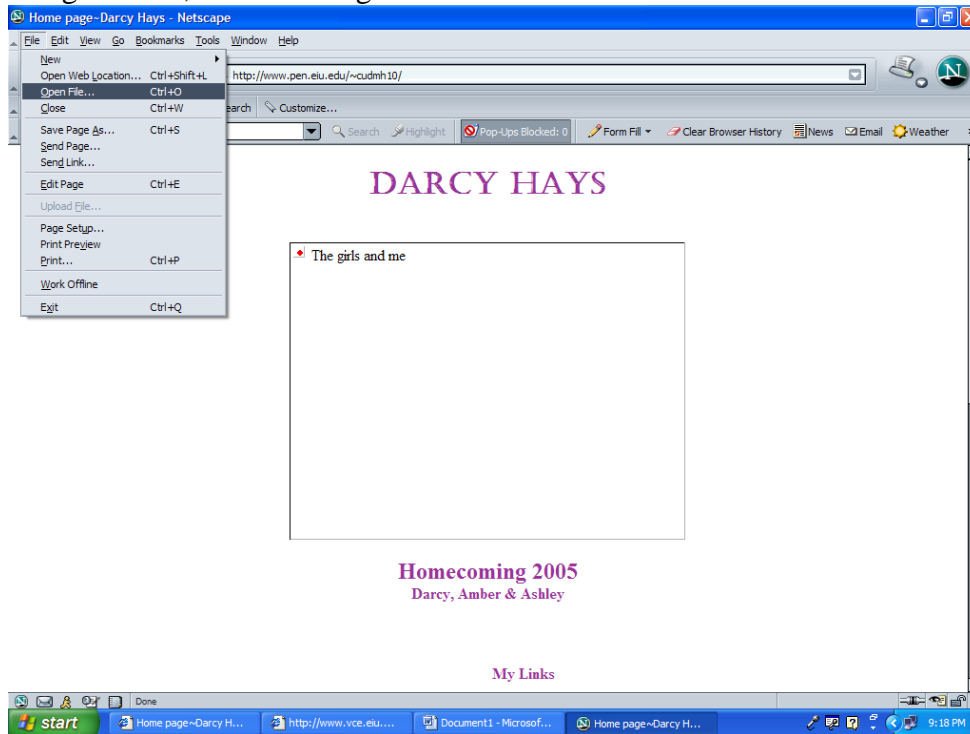


## Checking for problems with web page in Netscape

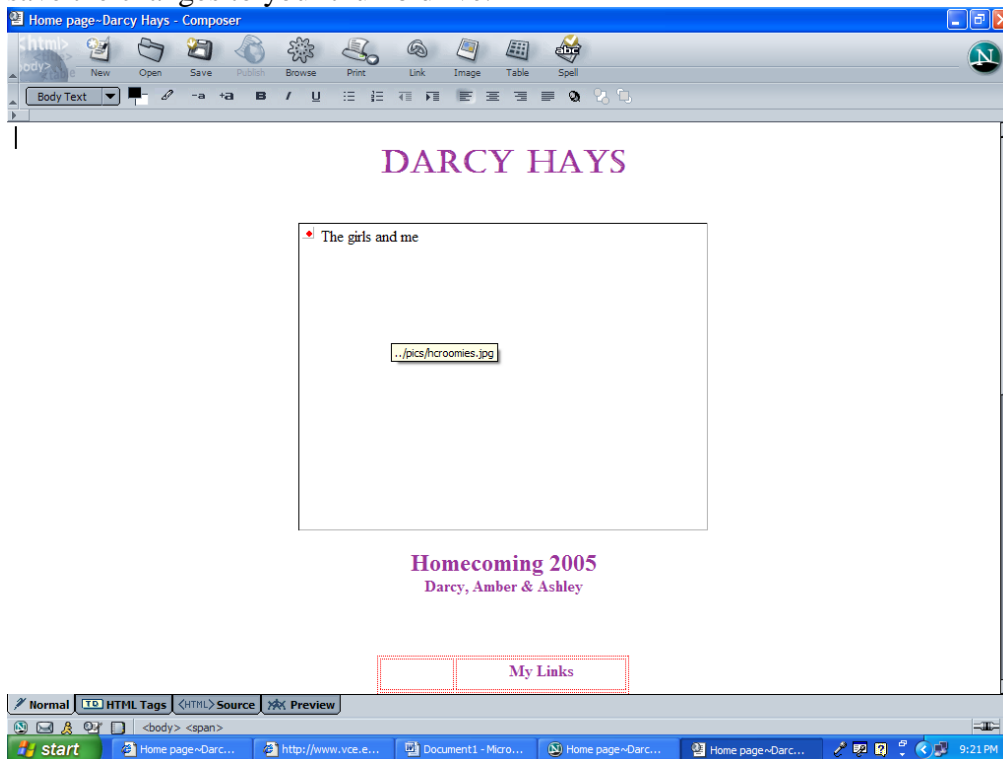
1. There are some things that you can check that may be causing you problems.
  - First of all your home page must be saved as index.html (It has to be a lower case i, and it cannot have any numbers in it!!!)
  - Make sure that any web pages that you have created do not have spaces in the title!!!
  - Make sure that you have every graphic, picture, document, web page saved in **ONE** folder.
  - Make sure your graphics or pictures are saved as .gif or .jpg (lower case). If the graphic is saved with lots of numbers and symbols you may need to rename them.
  - If you rename a graphic, image, web page, you will have to redo your links and insert the images again.
  - Be sure to look at the direction sheet that I gave you for creating your web pages in Netscape, they are very detailed.
  - Do not check to see if your pages are posted while your thumb drive is in the computer. Either take out your thumb drive or check your web pages on another computer.
2. It is easier to see some of your problems after you have posted your web pages. You will need to open up Netscape 7.2 Browser. Do **not** put your thumb drive in the computer yet.
3. Then type in your web address: <http://www.pen.eiu.edu/~cudmh10> (I'm using Darcy's as an example.) Notice that this is opened in Netscape and NOT in Internet Explorer. Look in the right hand corner—see this is opened in Netscape.



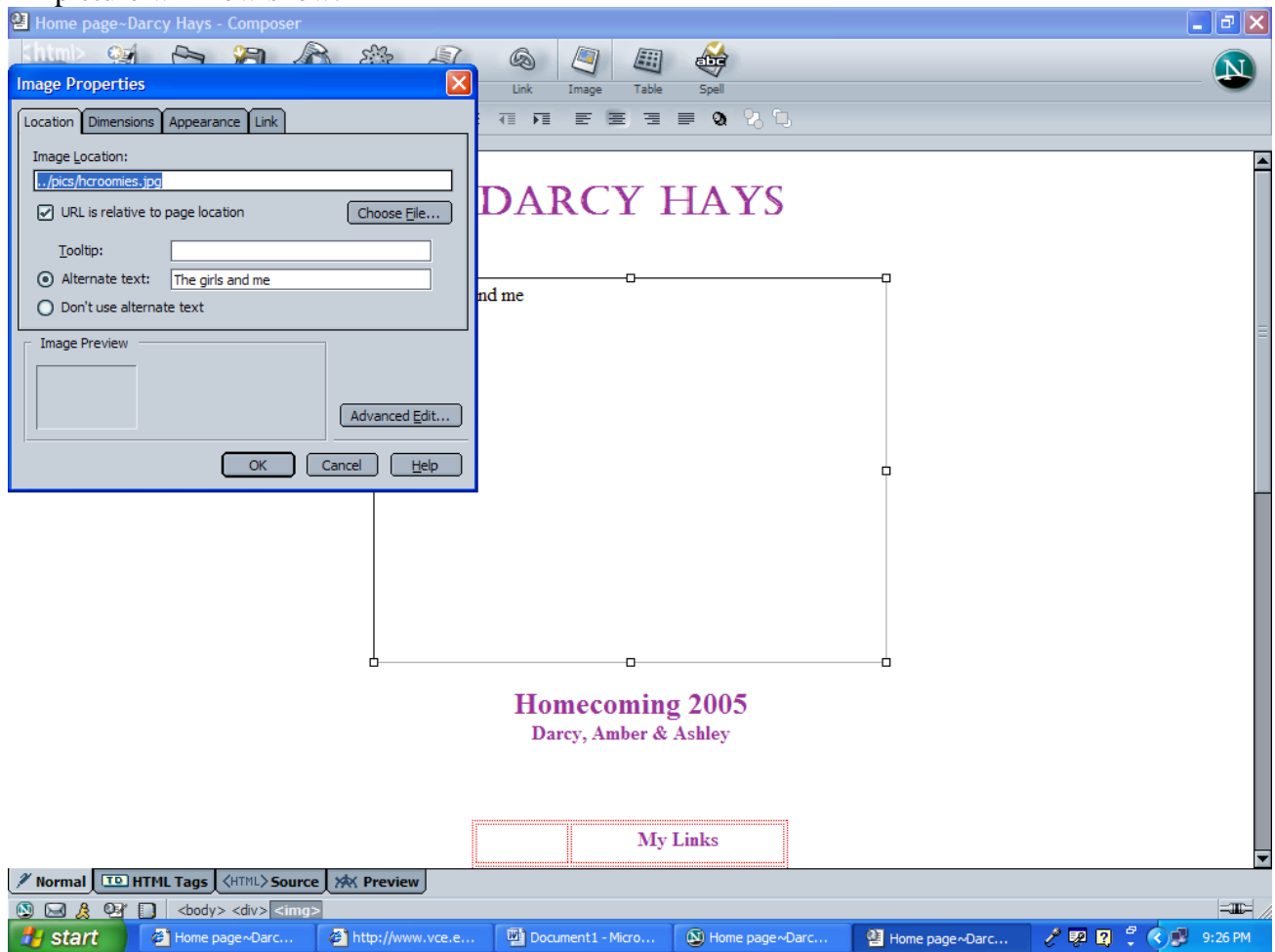
4. Now go to File, then Edit Page.



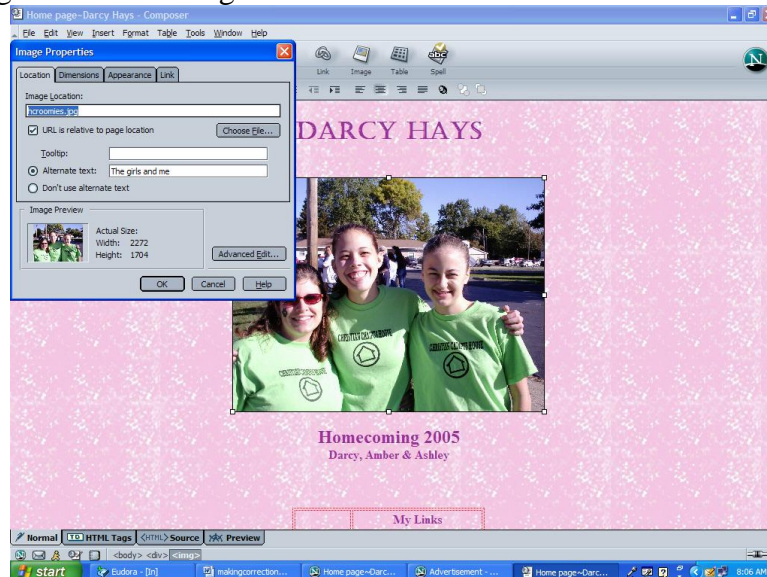
5. This screen shows the page like it is opened in composer. You can make corrections more easily now, because you will not have conflicting information from your thumb drive, or floppy disk. After you make changes you will want to save the changes to your thumb drive.



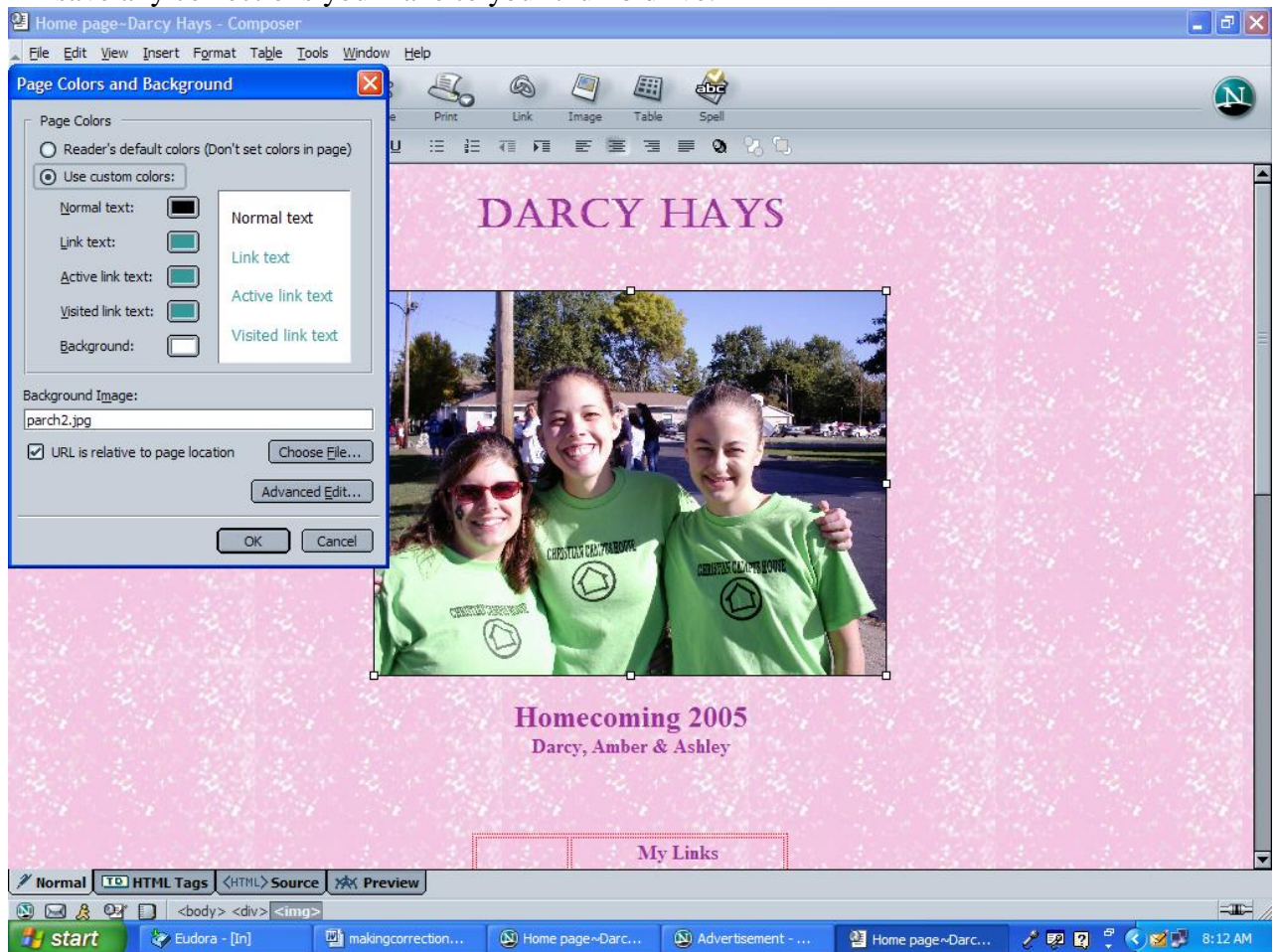
6. Notice that the picture that Darcy posted is not showing up. So select the image icon. Get rid of all of the information in front of and including the slash mark. The picture will now show.



7. The image is now showing.



8. If your background is not showing up, check how you have it names. If it does not have numbers, spaces, etc. Then you can check how it is posted. Go to Format and select Format Page Colors and Background. You might just want to first delete what you have and select Reader's Default Colors. Then select OK, this will kind of reset your page so you can do it over. Or if you have extraneous symbols, letters, numbers, etc. like you did with the image above then delete all the way until the name of your background selection. If you have it done correctly this is the information that you should have. Notice it says parch2.jpg and notice that there is a  $\sqrt{\quad}$  in the box marked URL is relative to page location. Be sure to save any corrections you make to your thumb drive.
