

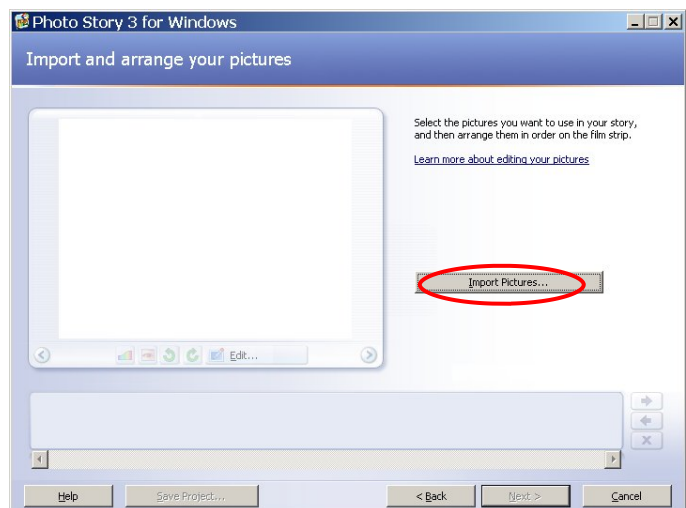
PhotoStory 3

How to Create an Easy Slide Show

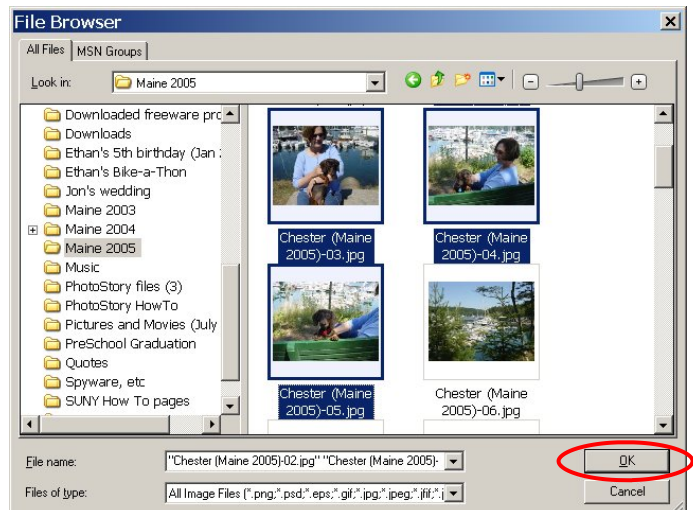
1. Start PhotoStory 3. Be sure the dot is in front of “Begin a new story.” Click on “Next.”



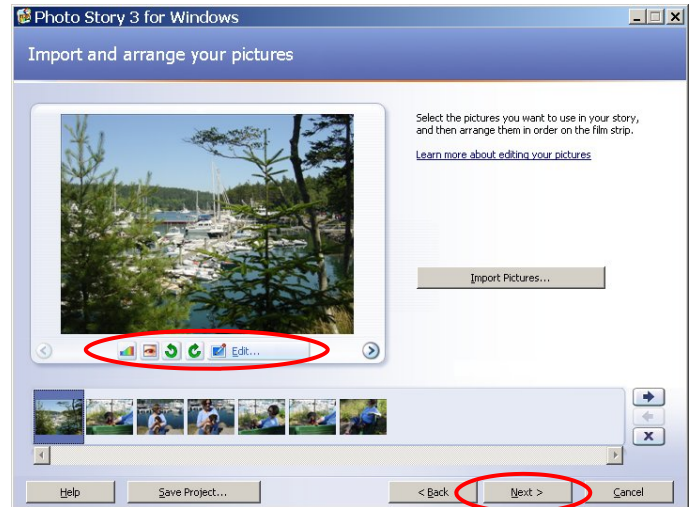
2. Click on “Import Pictures.”



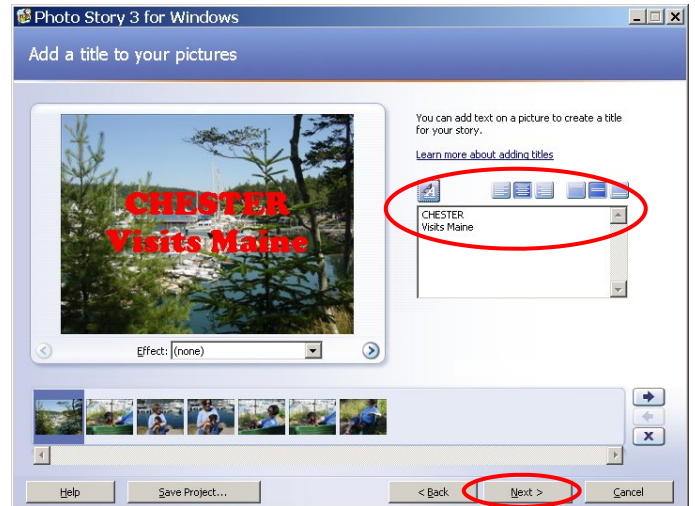
3. Browse to the folder containing your pictures. Hold the CTRL key down. Click on each picture you want to include in the slide show. When you're done, click on “OK.”



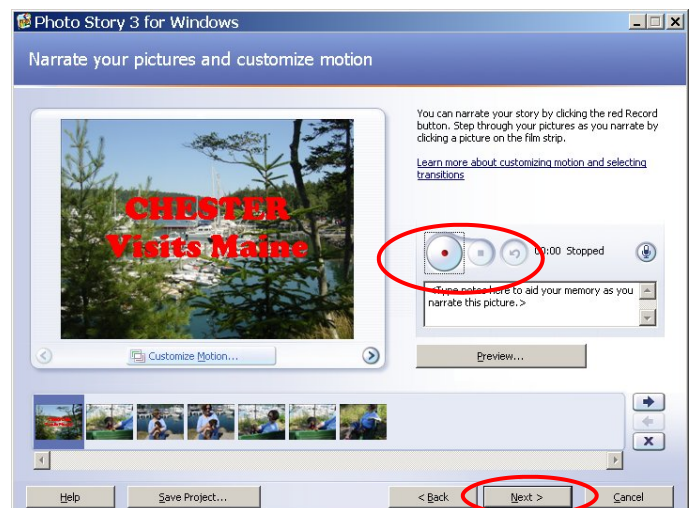
4. Rearrange the order of your pictures (if you want to). Explore the various editing options under each picture (brightness, remove red-eye, rotate, etc.). Click “Next” when you’re done.



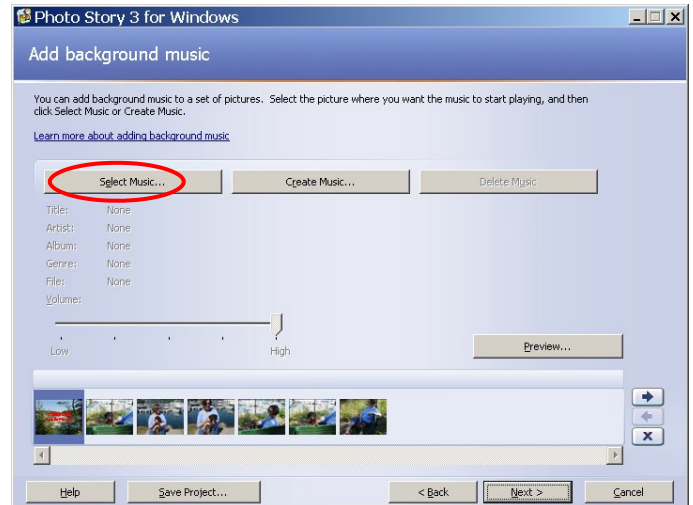
5. Optional: Add a title to the first slide. Change the font, color, etc. Click on “Next” when you’re done.



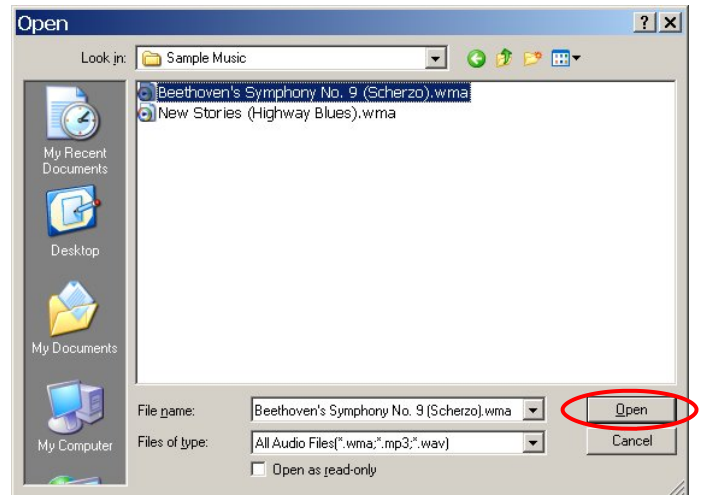
6. Optional: If you have a microphone, you can add voice narration to each slide. Click on “Next” when you’re done.



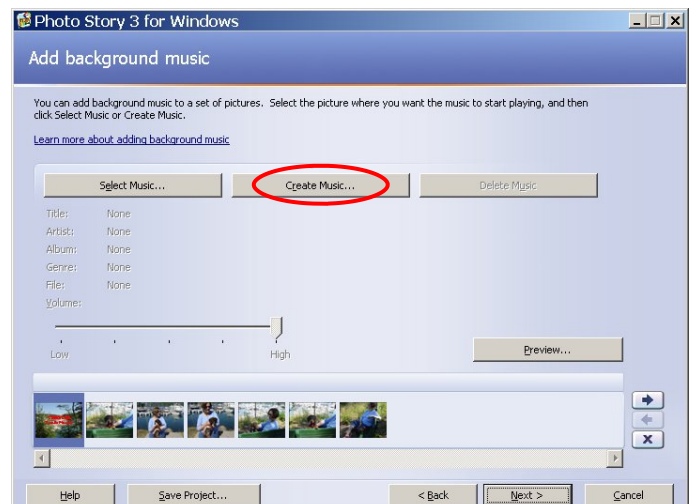
7. You have two choices for adding music to your slide show. If you already have your own music files, click on “Select Music.”



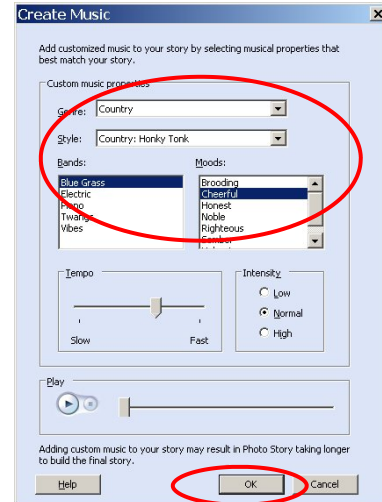
8. Browse to the folder containing your music, select the music file you want to use. Click on “Open.”



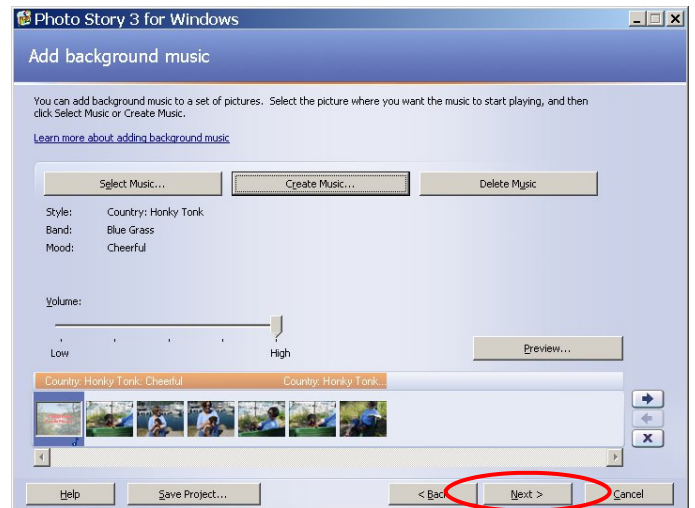
9. If you would prefer to create your own music, click on the “Create Music” button.



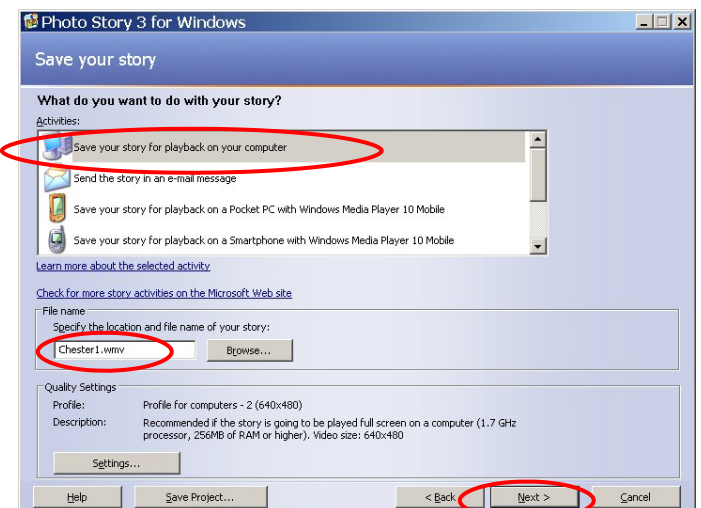
10. Select a genre, style, mood, etc. When you're done, click on "OK."



11. After selecting (or creating) your music, click on "Next."



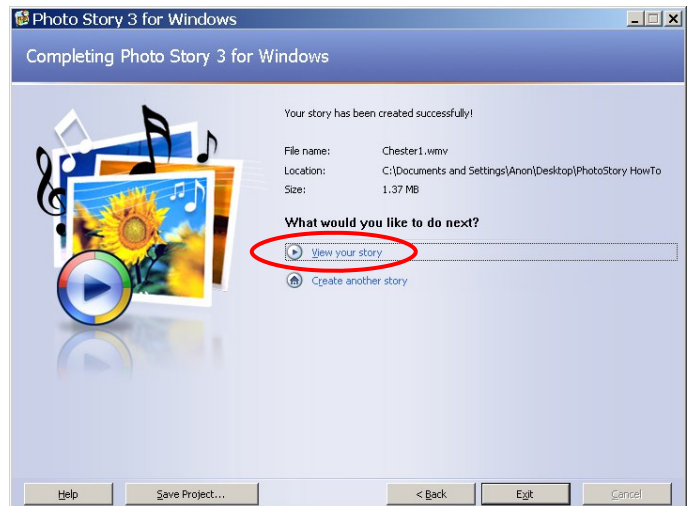
12. It's time to save your slide show. Browse to an appropriate location. Create a name for your file. Click on "Next."



13. PhotoStory will now build your slide show. This may take several minutes.



14. It's now time to view your newly-created slide show. Click on "View Your Story."



15. It's important to save your slide show a second time, as a "project." If you don't do this, you won't ever be able to edit your slide show.
